Reeling off the success of our first ever hybrid festival last year, F-O-R-M is returning again in live+digital formats!

Our **8th annual festival** will take place November 4-18, co-presented by SFU Woodward's Cultural Programs.

F-O-R-M is an international movement-on-screen festival that centers the voices of youth and emerging artists. We screen and commission films that explore the limitless possibilities of the body in motion through film. We provide a platform to support early-career artists in the exploration of this medium while introducing our audiences to expansive, genre-defying filmmaking.

F-O-R-M presents films that investigate the body in motion through curiosity, experimentation, and imagination.

Recorded Movement is the theme - any movement or dance practices, genres, or styles are invited. We are interested in how movement can be utilized as a vehicle for expression. How do you define movement? How do you portray this definition within your practice or discipline? How does this movement collaborate with film? We invite your dreams and concepts around the theme of Recorded Movement, and to challenge this definition as you see fit!

F-O-R-M strongly encourages and prioritizes applications from Youth artists, and those from intersecting identities and traditionally marginalized communities; Black, Indigenous, People of Colour, folks with disabilities, and diverse sexual orientations, gender identities, or expressions (LGBTQ2S+).

SPONSORSHIP BENEFITS & VISIBILITY

As our festival continues to grow, so does our audience and reach. During our pivot to an online festival in 2020, we saw a 223% increase in attendance. To maintain connections with our international audiences that started tuning in during the pandemic, we successfully presented our 2022 festival as a hybrid format for the first time - offering our programming in both live and digital formats.

In 2022, we:

- had over 460 festival attendees between in-person and digital platforms
- over 235 people browsed our digital program guide
- over 800 views on our Vimeo showcases across three screenings
- and saw a 23% increase in social media followers during the festival

Since launching in October 2015 and having our first festival back in June 2016, we have seen a steady growth on social media.

Facebook (<u>@formvancouver</u>) has over **2,200** followers, with the majority of our fans being between the ages of 18-34. On Instagram (<u>@formvancouver</u>), we have over **3,200** followers, the majority of which are in this same demographic.

CO-COMMISSIONING PARTNER

What is a Commission? Every year, F-O-R-M commissions youth and emerging artists with \$3000 towards the creation of a new movement-on-screen creation which premieres at our festival. Our commissioning program is an opportunity for artists to develop their creative voices through experimentation and collaboration.

As a Co-Commissioning Partner, your organization will be matched with a Commissioned artist. Our Artistic Directors take careful consideration to your organizational mandates and values in matching you with the appropriate artist and their film's themes. Your contribution goes directly into the artist's hands and will support their film financially.

MINI CO-COMMISSIONING PARTNER

What is a Mini Commission? F-O-R-M also commissions High School Aged Youth to create a 1-2 minute film to premiere on our Instagram page during our festival. Ten young artists (ages 15-18) are awarded \$500 towards the creation of their new film. From July to August, artists participate in creative workshops, receive mentorship, and take part in peer-to-peer feedback sessions to support their filmmaking processes.

As a youth-driven festival, we've seen firsthand the power that young artists have when their creative voices are empowered. Since launching this program in 2022, we are now looking for Mini Co-Commissioning Partners to help support these filmmakers.
